Message from the Presidents

News & Events

Though recently it has felt more like January than May, time is really moving along, and it is a surprise that June is already looming close on the horizon. The new hours are into operation and there are still many patrons who come to the door of the Sharp Park Library on Mondays and Fridays, but overall, the change has gone fairly smoothly. The extra closed day does cause a back up of demand on the following day, and especially for computer time. It really brings home the need for one library that can be open seven days a week. The negotiations with the Coastal Commission are continuing and the city is hiring a development consultant to help with the negotiations.

The other major change is the installation of the new FIND IT book category system that replaces the Dewey decimal system with subject words. New labeling and signage are being installed at both libraries that will make it easier to find books on the subject you are interested in.

Meanwhile the PFOL has been busily preparing for our up-coming book sale **Friday, June 12**, and **Saturday, June 13**. Donations have been pouring in, and special thanks go to the book nook workers who keep the donation box emptied and sorted. Because we have so many books, we are asking that anyone who has a large donation please keep it until **June 11**, after 11 am. Our small storage space is overflowing thanks to your generosity. Please mark your calendars and plan to spend a while browsing our fantastic collection including CDs, DVDs, and books on

disc. Sports, birds, and Science Fiction/Fantasy are the heaviest categories this time, along with cookbooks of every type.

We need our sale to be a success as we voted last month to give the library \$6,000 for summer programs. This includes the Summer Learning Program for children which has a goal of signing up 2,700 kids. Part of the money, (\$2,500) will go towards helping pay for books to be given to all children who sign up. Also, the money will cover performers, other programs, and a movie license so we can continue to show the popular family night movies. Thanks to all of you who make this possible through your generous support.
