Message from the Co-Presidents

It is hard to believe that summer is upon us very soon. The sunny days of January and February gave way to the refreshing rains in March, lessening the threat of drought, but not eliminating it. The rain worked miracles turning the hills green and encouraging the plants to bloom. Now June is coming soon and with it our semi-annual book sale.

June also brings the big Summer Learning Program for Pacifica's children. The Library has already received over 5,000 new books to be given to the participants. This is the biggest and most expensive program of the year and stretches out from June to August. We are hoping for a successful sale to help fund this program, and invite you to come and browse our incredible selection of media and books. You get a bargain, and the library gets funding- a win-win all the way.

The Library Advisory Committee will be beginning its outreach program to ask your input on the new plan approved by the City Council. The plan calls for a

new library at the Sharp Park site with underground parking, and updating Sanchez and keeping it open. Watch for the information kiosks at upcoming community events like the Farmers Market and 4th of July celebration. Meanwhile, the Half Moon Bay Library is nearing completion and will be open for tours this summer. Take a spin down the coast and see what a modern library has to offer.

This year San Mateo County is requiring that the library submit fingerprints of all volunteers at the library. This will probably happen in June, with the date and times to be announced. There will be two sessions, one at each library. We will send an email to our volunteers when the date is confirmed.

The library hosted two volunteer appreciation parties on April 28. We hope all our dedicated volunteers were able to come to either Sharp Park of Sanchez. We would like to add our appreciation also. Without our wonderful volunteers, we wouldn't be able to support the many programs offered. Thank You!

Our board has made two recent purchases that will improve our book sales. We bought metal shelving so we do not have to worry about toppling stacks of books and some folding book cases for the children's section. We still have room for a few members at large on the board and a couple of openings for the book nook. If you are interested, leave your contact information at the desk of either library.
